Be in Good Standing

A PTA unit is "in good standing" if it:

- Remits dues to the state by the 1st of each month
- Has bylaws approved every three years;
- Submits a copy of the unit's fiscal year end report to the state PTA by December 1st of each year;
- Submits a copy of the unit's annual financial review (formerly known as the audit) to the state PTA by December 1st of each year;
- Submits a copy of the required IRS tax form to the state PTA by December 1st of each year;
- Submits the names and addresses of officers to the state PTA by March 31st of each year; and

PTA Registration & Reporting Instructions:

- Register Your PTA from July 1—January 1 at PTA.org/Reflections.
- . Enter your National PTA 8-digit ID Number.
- . Enter your PTA Name, City, State, ZIP.
- . Enter your PTA Leader Name, Title, Address, City, State, ZIP.
- Enter your School Name, Number of Students Enrolled, Title I Status (Y/N), Percent of students who receive free/reduced priced lunches.
- . Enter your additional contacts who wish to receive program communications from State and National PTA.
- . Click "Submit" and receive a confirmation email.
- 2. Report Student Participation & Program Success from September 1-March 1 at PTA.org/Reflections.
- . Enter your National PTA 8-digit ID Number.
- · Select which grade divisions your PTA offered.
- · For each division, Enter student participation totals for each arts category.
- Enter total number of participating students.
- Select true statements regarding your program's success.
- Click "Submit" and receive a confirmation email

Student Entry Portal Instructions:

- 1. Create an Account.
- Visit PTA org/Reflections and click the "Submit Student Entry" button.
- . Click "sign up" and enter your full name, email and create a password.
- . Click "register" and receive a confirmation email.
- Click the unique link in your confirmation email to activate your account.

2. Submit Advancing Student Entries.

- . From your account's home page, click "create a submission" for each student entry advancing to the next round.
- . Click "Student Entry Form" to enter Student Entry Information.
- . Click "Upload Artwork" to upload a digital copy of the entrant's artwork (optional).
- Click "submit your student entry" to submit student entry. If you submit a student entry by accident or need to
 make edits to completed forms, please notify your State PTA.

3. Confirm Student Submission Status.

- From your account's home page, view a list of created submissions. Confirmed submissions will show a status of "Submitted."
- · Look for State and National PTA award announcements and special invitations to Reflections celebration events.

Guide for Online Portals

Step 1: Register Your Unit

- July 1 November 1
- Use the Guide for Online Portals
- You will need to know your unit's 8-digit ID#
- Have other information listed on guide ready
- Go to www.pta.org to register
- Watch for confirmation email


Step 2: Prepare Art Work

- Review the specific art category rules for the acceptable file format
- Verify existing digital files (dance, film production & music composition) are correct format
- Create digital files if needed
 - i.e. scan literature, take pictures of photography or visual arts
- Label files correctly by renaming & saving

Visual Arts Forms

- 2D Forms: Architectural drawing, collages, photographic collages, computer-generated image, drawing, painting, printmaking.
- Dimensions must not exceed 24x30 inches, including matting.
- Paper entries must be mounted on sturdy material.
- 1 digital file uploaded

Images of Reflections Student Artwork

- **3D Forms:** Architectural model, carpentry, ceramics, design, dioramas, fiber work, jewelry, kites, metal etching/punch work, mobiles, sculpture and wind chimes.
- Artwork must be able to move for display purposes.
- Must include packaging materials and 3 photos of the entry (a combination of angles) for judging, ID and exhibition purposes (entries that require assembling/repairing from transporting will be disqualified).
- When labeling the files include view1, view2, view3



Follow the Student Entry Portal Instructions on the Guide to the Online Portals

- 1. Create an account
- 2. Submit the entries by December 17th
- 3. Confirm each student's submission status

1. Create an Account

- Go to PTA.org/reflections
- Click "Submit Student Entry"
- Click "sign up" and enter YOUR NAME, YOUR EMAIL & create a password (write it down ⊕)
- Click "register"
- Check your email for the confirmation email
- Click the unique link in the email to activate your account

That Was Easy!



2. Submit Advancing Entries

- Go to your account's "home page"
- Click "create a submission"
- Click "Student Entry Form" and enter the information from the hard copy of the student's entry form
- Click "Upload Artwork" to upload the digital file of the artwork. You will get that "browse" option to go to doc file, click on it then upload
- Click "Submit your student entry"

3. Confirm Student Submission Status

- Go to your account's "home page"
- You can view the list of the created submissions
- Confirmed submissions will show a status of "Submitted"
