

FEDERAL ASSISTANCE TO EDUCATION

- WHEREAS, The role of education has become increasingly important to the country's interest as well as to the individual; and
- WHEREAS, Federal assistance to the present programs has been channeled successfully through the State Department of Elementary and Secondary Education for benefit of Missouri's children in vocational education, library services, school lunch, exceptional children, and for federally impacted areas; and
- WHEREAS, Local boards of education presently receive supplemental program funding through federal grants; therefore, be it
- RESOLVED, That the Missouri Congress of Parents and Teachers supports the principle of greater financial responsibility for public education by the federal government only if it will insure maximum local control.
