

FINANCING EDUCATION

- WHEREAS, Adequate funding of public education has always been a priority of Missouri Congress of Parents and Teachers; and
- WHEREAS, The Missouri Congress of Parents and Teachers is concerned about maintaining the ability of the local property tax to elicit the necessary funds to maintain local control of education; and
- WHEREAS, The Missouri Congress of Parents and Teachers has long supported legislation to provide additional local and state revenue and sources of revenue; therefore, be it
- RESOLVED, That the Missouri Congress of Parents and Teachers supports legislation that will maintain or generate local and state funding for public education; and, be it further
- RESOLVED, That the Missouri Congress of Parents and Teachers supports appropriations that would distribute the cost of public education to at least fifty percent (50%) to be maintained by the state.
