RESOLVED,	That the Missouri Congress of Parents and Teachers urge all PTA councils and units to provide and strengthen drug education and prevention programs to parents, teachers and students, and be it further
RESOLVED,	That the Missouri Congress of Parents and Teachers encourage legislators to create and promote enforcement of laws that prohibit the manufacture, sale and abuse of illegal and "look-alike" synthetic drugs.
