## CHILD ABUSE

WHEREAS, The phenomena of nationwide child abuse annually results in

untold tragedy and suffering for unknown numbers of children;

and

WHEREAS, The causes of child abuse are many and complex, crossing social,

economic, and educational lines; and

WHEREAS, A contributing cause may be lack of parental knowledge of

children's physical, emotional, and social needs; therefore be it

RESOLVED, That PTA and PTSAs develop and promote parent and family life

programs that address themselves to the problem of child abuse, its causes and prevention, and that they encourage and support family life education curricula in the schools so that all future parents may be better able to cope with the problems of parenthood and family

responsibilities; and, be it further

RESOLVED, That all local units and councils be urged to present programs on

child abuse; and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Missouri Congress of Parents and Teachers urge the State Legislature to provide funds to local public agencies so that the

following service could be instituted for child abusers:

1. Organize a 24 hour hotline to deal with crisis;

2. Parents Anonymous Volunteers-facilities and leadership to

provide for group sessions

3. Abused Child's Attorney-having a specialist in family laws assigned to the assisting agency for the protection and

representation of the child;

4. Lay Therapy-volunteers to work on a person-to-person basis

with abusive parents.
