RESOLVED, That the Missouri Congress of Parents and Teachers its units and

councils urge the Legislature to continue to insure effective laws to prohibit the use of children in the creation and production of obscene, pornographic and violent material and to protect minors

from sexual abuse in any form; and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Missouri Congress of Parents and Teachers urge its units

and councils to support law enforcement agencies in their efforts to

eliminate sexual abuse of children.
