PUBLIC PARENT-EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION

WHEREAS, There is general recognition of the necessity for adequate

developmental skills for all young children before entering

elementary education; and

WHEREAS, The Missouri State Department of Elementary and Secondary

Education has created a Division of Early Childhood Education to assist in the development of programs for the education of the

parent/young child; and

WHEREAS, Provision for funding of school district early childhood education

programs for the handicapped is included in HB 474 (Special

Education Act); therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That local boards of education be encouraged to study and adopt

appropriate public parent-early childhood education programs in

their school districts; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the Missouri State Board of Education seek additional means

of financing local public parent-early childhood education

programs.
