STUDENT TRANSPORTATION AID

WHEREAS, The PTA is committed to securing adequate laws for the protection

and welfare of children and youth; and

WHEREAS, State transportation aid is determined by the most effective and

economical routes; and

WHEREAS, School districts are penalized in the calculation of state

transportation aid when transporting students, forcing school districts to transport students at district expense or to charge

parents for transportation; therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Missouri Congress of Parents and Teachers, its units and

councils, lend its collective support to changes in the state transportation aid formula to allow school districts to transport

students in the safest manner without financial penalty.
