

## UNIFORM SCHOOL SPEED LIMITS/SIGNS

- WHEREAS, The Missouri Congress of Parents and Teachers is concerned with the safety of children and youth; and
- WHEREAS, The school speed limits and posting of speed limits and school area signs vary, making compliance difficult for drivers; therefore, be it
- RESOLVED, That the Missouri Congress of Parents and Teachers encourage its member units and councils to have local, city, county and state officials establish uniform school speed limits, not to exceed 25 miles per hour, and to post these limits and school area signs on all sides of every school; and, be it further
- RESOLVED, That the Missouri Congress of Parents and Teachers encourage its member units and councils to encourage local, city, county and state law enforcement officials to enforce speed limits in school areas.
