LICENSING OF NON PUBLIC SCHOOLS

WHEREAS, There are presently no accreditation guidelines for non public

schools in Missouri; and

WHEREAS, Compulsory school attendance laws require students from the ages

of seven to sixteen to attend school; and

WHEREAS, At present, non certified and untrained teachers may open a

"school" and have no requirements on number of days per year or

hours per day; therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Missouri Congress of Parents and Teachers, its units and

councils, urge the Missouri General Assembly to require licensing of any academic school educating children between the ages of five, on or before October 1, to sixteen, setting minimum standards for qualifications of teachers, number of school days and hours of

attendance.
