





Phonological awareness is the ability to understand the individual sounds in spoken words. Beginning readers demonstrate phonological awareness by blending the separate sounds of a word to say the word.

Materials:

- Rhyme Bingo boards (provided)
- Tokens (bingo chips, pennies, or cotton balls)
- Lists of rhyming words (provided)



Preparation:

- Print the Rhyme Bingo boards (number will depend on how many participants you will have playing at once) and the list of rhyming words (one copy).
- On each Bingo board, write a variety of words from List 1.

Activity Instructions:

- 1. Pass out Rhyme Bingo boards (with words written in each square) to each family member.
- 2. Call out words from **List 2**, one at a time.
- 3. When players see a word on their board that rhymes with the word called out, they cover that word with a token.
- 4. Players win when they cover a row: horizontally, vertically or diagonally.
