Missouri PTA must account to the IRS the 'Unit in Good Standing" status of each PTA. To do this, we require that you submit signed copies of the following documents to Missouri PTA:

- Annual Financial Review (Audit)
- Treasurer's Year-End Fiscal Report
- IRS Form 990N (e-Postcard)

Most small tax-exempt organizations whose annual gross receipts (includes all money deposited in a PTA account except the state and national portions of dues) are normally \$50,000 or less can satisfy their annual reporting requirement by electronically submitting Form 990-N if they choose not to file Form 990 or Form 990-EZ instead.
