



## Missouri PTA Leaders Project

The Missouri PTA Leaders Project was initiated to encourage and recognize leadership accomplishment and enable PTA leaders to function effectively. This project also provides information to the PTA State Board members as they attempt to identify leadership qualities among our members.

The Missouri PTA Leaders Project is a two-year project that begins when a participant attends his/her first Missouri PTA approved training event. There are twenty (20) different categories of leadership training opportunities that qualify for this recognition, which are listed below. The project is completed when the participant finishes ten (10) DIFFERENT categories, (i.e. not 2 of #4). All ten (10) must be completed within two calendar years.

Each time the participant attends an approved training event, a Missouri PTA Board Member will sign your tracking card. It is the responsibility of the participant to keep track of the signed tracking card. Applications must be received by the March 1<sup>st</sup> deadline. Each recipient will be notified that their application has been approved. The applicants will receive the "Certified PTA Leader" certificate and pin at the next Missouri PTA Convention, be recognized in *CONTACT* and on our website.

5. Attend a Missouri PTA approved Regional Conference, including participating in a workshop.	15. Attend a Missouri PTA approved National PTA Program workshop.
6. Attend a Missouri PTA approved School of Information.	16. Attend a Missouri PTA approved special workshop through a Council or Region .
7. Attend a Missouri PTA approved Parliamentary workshop.	17. Volunteer at a Missouri PTA Annual Convention .
8. Attend a Missouri PTA approved Bylaws workshop.	18. Volunteer at a National PTA Convention.
9. Attend a Missouri PTA approved Finance workshop.	19. Serve in an elected PTA position .
10. Attend a Missouri PTA approved Advocacy Training workshop.	20. Attend Child Advocacy Day.
