INFORMATION

The Missouri Congress of Parents and Teachers awards Teacher Education Scholarships up to \$500.00 per year for the purpose of educating students of outstanding ability and sincerity of purpose who will enter the teaching profession. Students graduating from an accredited Missouri public high school in a district with at least one PTA unit in good standing, and who are pursuing a Missouri State Teaching Credential, may apply for the scholarships. Scholarships will be awarded based on **character, academic record, and volunteerism, and may also be awarded based on financial status**. Applicants must attend a Missouri junior college, college, or university.

Upon notification of selection, applicants must submit the *Agreement and Acceptance Form*, along with a current school or passport photograph, within 10 days of receipt of the form or the scholarship will be offered to an alternate applicant.

Scholarships may be renewed annually in the fall, contingent upon submittal of the *Scholarship Renewal Form*. In addition, the student must provide a yearly transcript which contains a minimal 2.5 GPA, and an update of school activities and accomplishments, reflecting a posture consistent with the high standards projected in the award of the scholarship. Scholarship awards will conclude after a total of four years receipt or the attainment of an education degree, provided that sufficient scholarship funds are available.

Scholarship recipients of the DILLARD A. MALLORY or IRMA G. DETJEN Scholarship must work as a teacher in a Missouri public school one year for every two years of scholarship funds received. Following graduation, scholarship recipients must submit the *Certificate of Teaching Form*, signed by the principal, superintendent, or school board president, to the Missouri PTA Scholarship Chairperson by July 15 of each of the two years.

- 3. Provide a current certified high school transcript that includes the fall semester grades.
- 4. The application, confidential report (on the back of the application), transcript, release form, and letters of recommendation **must be mailed in one envelope, or the application will be disqualified,** to the Scholarship Committee c/o Missouri PTA (The address is located on the confidential report section of the application) or emailed to scholarships@mopta.org in one .pdf file.
- 5. The completed application packet must be postmarked or emailed on or before February 15th of each year. Late applications will not be considered. One application packet per school is allowed to be submitted. Multiple application packets submitted from the same school will disqualify all application packets from that school.

(*The confidential report form is **not** one of the letters of recommendation.)

- 1. Beginning with the 2007-2008 school year, Missouri's community colleges began offering an Associate of Arts in Teaching Degree. Students who pursue a degree in education and plan to attend a Missouri community college, and then transfer to a Missouri public or independent four-year institution with teacher preparation programs, are eligible to submit this application.
- 2. Teacher Education Scholarships are financed from the investment income earned by Missouri PTA Scholarship Funds. Gifts from PTA Units, Councils, Missouri State PTA, earmarked donations, fundraising and half the cost of Missouri Distinguished Service Awards, contribute to the Missouri PTA Scholarship Funds. Current Missouri PTA Scholarships are:
 - Caroline B. Ullman established in 1923 to honor Mrs. William Ullmann of Springfield, President of Missouri PTA at the time.
 - **Dillard A. Mallory** established in 1962 by D.A. Mallory, former superintendent of Dallas County R-1(Buffalo School District). This scholarship is awarded to a student preparing to teach social studies.
 - **Irma G. Detjen** established in 1967 by Mr. C. Wheeler Detjen in memory of Irma Detjen, President of Missouri PTA from 1952-1955
 - **Helen B. Maupin** established in 1992 by former trustee and chairman of the scholarhsip program, Helen B. Maupin, to help deserving students become teachers.
